

AIRPORTS George F. L. Charles Airport



The George F.L. Charles during the month of February handled a total of 1,856 aircraft movements and 16,446 international and domestic passengers in and out of the airport as well as 4,535 intransit passengers. The airport also handled 98,881 kilograms of cargo set down and picked up.

Hewanorra International Airport

Hewanorra International Airport (HIA) during the month facilitated a total of 1,218 domestic and international aircraft movements (landed and take-off). HIA also facilitated 48,641 passengers disembarking and embarking in addition to 5,026 intransit passengers. Cargo throughput (landed and loaded) at the airport during the month was 93,695 kilograms.
