

George F. L. Charles Airport

George F.L. Charles Airport (GFLC) during the month of June recorded a total of 1,747 aircraft movements and 17,134 international and domestic passengers in and out of the airport in addition to 3,890 intransit passengers. The airport handled 108,338 kilograms of cargo set down and picked up.

#### Hewanorra International Airport

Hewanorra International Airport (HIA) facilitated a total of 960 domestic and international aircraft movements for the month. The airport also recorded 44,094 passengers (picked-up and set-down) and 6,486 intransit passengers. Cargo throughput (landed and loaded) at HIA for the month was 228,525 kilograms.

### Cargo Operations at Port Castries

During the month Port Castries handled container throughput of 1,257 TEUS landed and 1,010 TEUS loaded. The Port recorded breakbulk cargo throughput of 10,943 tons landed and 83 tons loaded.

The Port recorded 55 cargo vessels which discharged containers and break-bulk cargo.

#### Ferry Traffic

The Ferry Terminal this month welcomed 3 ferry calls carrying 758 passengers in (421) and out (337) of the Ferry Terminal at Port Castries. This low traffic level is as a result the placement of Express D'Isles's vessels on dry dock for cleaning and maintenance for most of the month.
