During the month of March, George F.L. Charles Airport (GFLC) handled a total of 2,298 aircraft movements accommodating 19,316 international and domestic passengers and 4,976 intransit passengers. The airport also handled 113,220 kilograms of cargo landed and loaded.

Hewanorra International Airport (HIA) recorded a total of 1,159 domestic and international aircraft movements for the month. Cargo Operations at Port Castries
